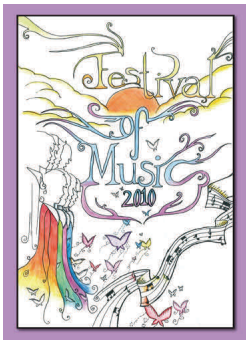


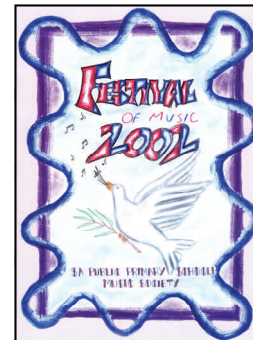


2018 SONGBOOK COVER & CONTENTS DESIGN Information for Teachers & Students



Each year the Festival of Music is the perfect vehicle for children's art work to be published and celebrated around Australia.

We invite Teachers (classroom and specialist arts) and Principals to seize this unique opportunity to encourage children with artistic flair and to promote this endeavour, not just within Festival Choir but to all children showing a talent and passion for art and design.



Work produced in any medium is acceptable, including work produced using digital technologies.

However, the design must be entirely the student's own work (no copying or tracing).

It is illegal to use or copy other people's ideas or images from printed material or online.

It is ESSENTIAL to you guide the students to:

This child-friendly web quest includes all the information critical for success, including information on next year's repertoire, design tips and previous covers (including finalists).

Your school technician can unblock this website if you are having trouble with your school's internet filter.



This year schools may submit two entries for the songbook cover competition,

PLUS two entries for the songbook illustrations and Cyc design competition.

Some selection process will need to take place at your school before they are sent to the Festival of Music Office for judging.



Please copy and distribute the entry form on the second page of this document and coach the children through the guidelines.

Please note that choir teachers must also check that any student who enters their work has a signed Media Permission Form from their parents/caregivers.



This project is for all students from Year 5-7.
They do not need to be a part of your Festival Choir.

COVER COMPETITION

- It features a theme from one or more of the choir songs.
- The main colours are strong.
- The shading is careful.
- I did not do this in a hurry. It was planned thoughtfully and done carefully.
- It is not cluttered with too many pictures or details.
- I understand drawings of kids holding hands, national flags, national costumes or the Earth are not recommended.
- I used **all** the space on the page and its orientation is **portrait** sized **A3**
- I tried to make it different from others I have seen before.
- I did not copy or trace anything (including clipart). It's all my own work.
- My choir teacher has sighted a signed Media Permission form.

The first prize winner will receive a \$75 gift voucher.

SONGBOOK ILLUSTRATIONS

I am sending this entry because..

- It features one idea from ONE of the choir songs.
- It is completed in greyscale (black and white)
- I did not do this in a hurry. It was planned thoughtfully and done carefully.
- I understand drawings of kids holding hands, national flags, national costumes or the Earth are not recommended.
- It's done on **A4 sized paper**.
- I did not copy or trace anything (including clipart). It's all my own work.
- I understand, if chosen, I give permission for my picture to be put in the 2016 songbook where it will be printed and distributed widely.
