Some errors made when using medium/s</p> <p>Instructions: Student has followed instructions to a poor standard with errors (see instructions under Excellent)</p> <p>Overall: Student has completed a poor final piece. A lack of thoughtfulness and care was taken in the presentation of the work</p>
